

FAQ's

1. What is Wasatch Figure Skating Club?

Wasatch Figure Skating Club is a non-profit organization designed to encourage and promote figure skating. Our Club is composed of people who love skating!!

2. Do I need to be competitive to be part of the Club?

NO!! The Wasatch Figure Skating Club is a great way to come and meet other skaters and make friends. There are competitive skaters and non-competitive skaters in our Club.

3. Do I need a coach to be part of the Club?

Again, no. You do not have to have a private coach to be part of the Club. However, the club is a great way to get to know the coaches as they do coach during Club Ice. You also have the opportunity to ask other skaters who their coaches are.

4. When is Club Ice?

Club Ice is held every Tuesday from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. This hour of ice is free to all club members. On the third Tuesday of each month (with the exception of the first Club Ice for the season) there is no coaching on Club Ice. We will have an activity planned for the first half hour and then the skaters will have the second half hour just to skate and have fun.

5. What does the Introductory Membership Include?

Wasatch Figure Skating Club offers an Introductory Membership for the first year at a cost of \$60.00. This membership entitles the skater to full member benefits including one hour of free ice each week. This is a significant cost savings and a great way to get to know all of the skaters.
